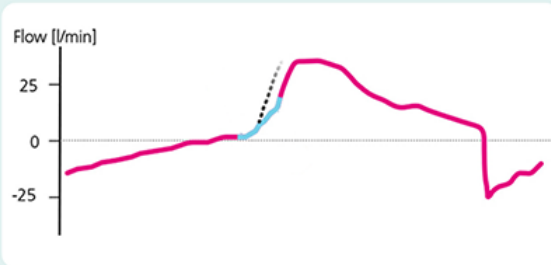
Country of origin: Romania

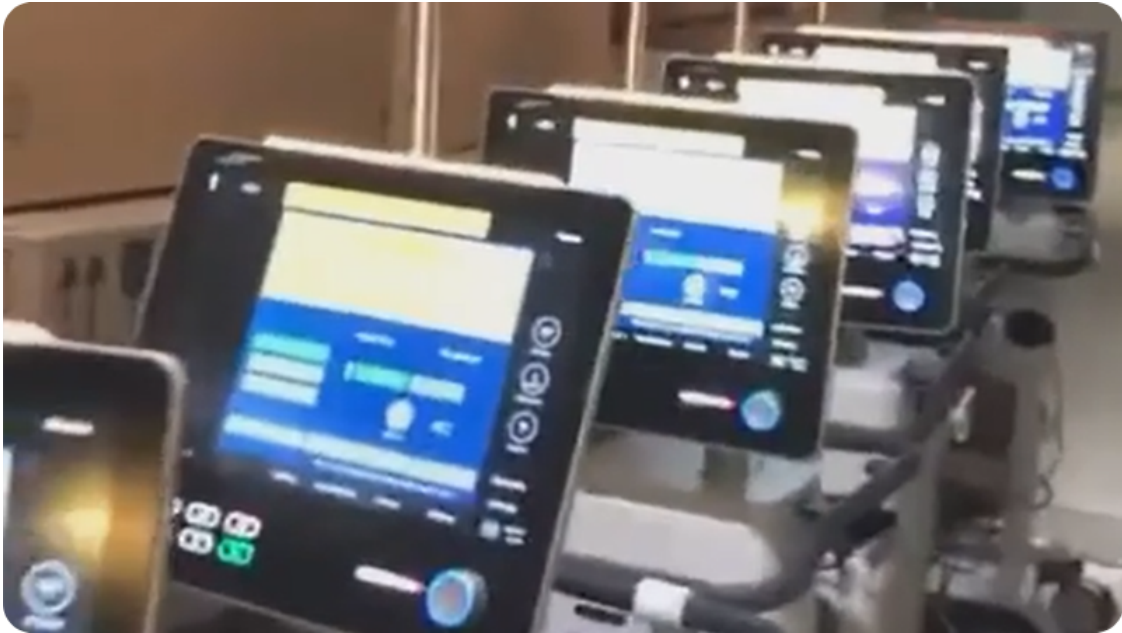

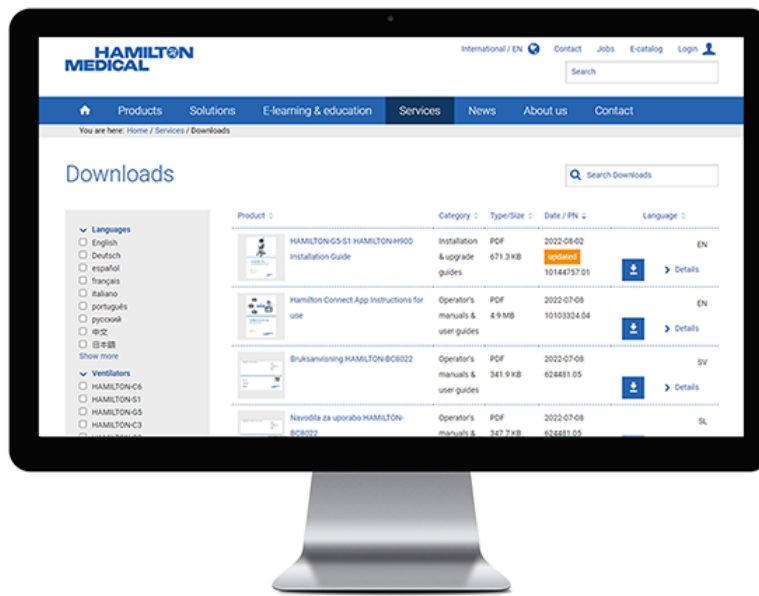

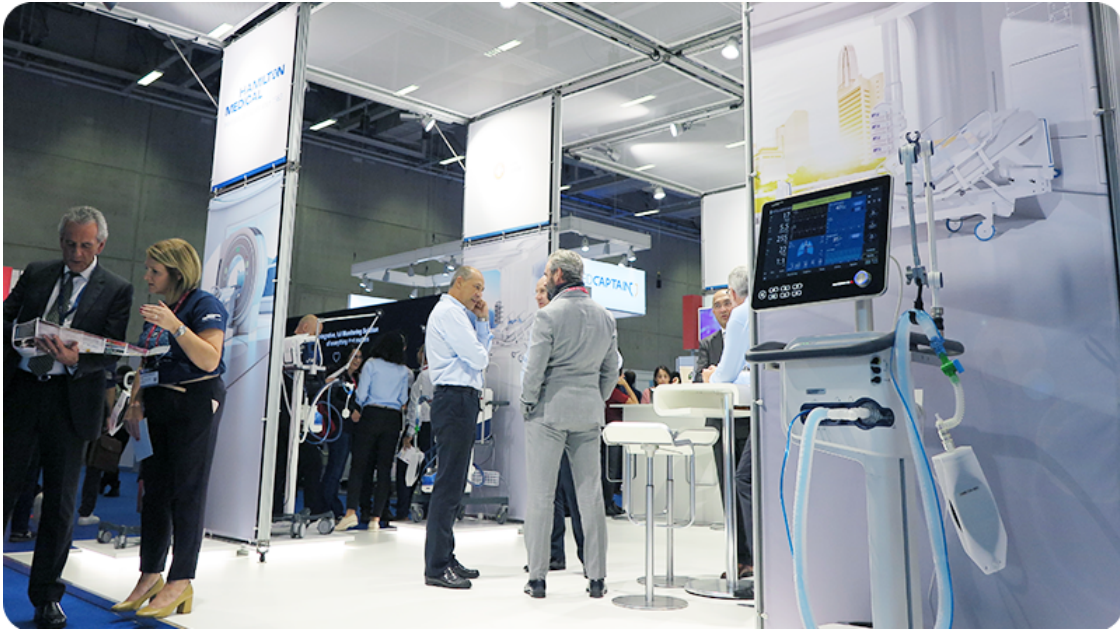
